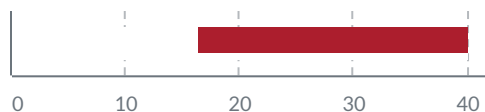

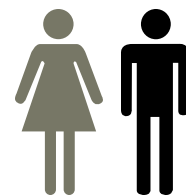


STATEWIDE DEMAND & WAGES

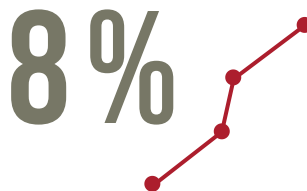
WAGE RANGE \$16 - 40 / HOUR
