JOB DESCRIPTION

DRYWALL FINISHING: Drywall finishers (or tapers) prepare unfinished interior drywall panels for painting by taping and finishing joints and imperfections.

GLAZIER: Glaziers cut, install, and remove glass in doors, windows, insulated glass units, show doors, mirrors, and glass tabletops.

GLASSWORKER: Glassworkers fabricate aluminum doors and windows, insulated glass units, show doors, mirrors and glass tabletops.

PAINTING + WALL COVERING: Painters and wall covering professionals work in commercial and industrial environments, from small to large scale projects.

SIGN DISPLAY + SCREEN PROCESS: Sign and display craft persons design, construct, paint and erect signage and trade show exhibits using a wide range of materials.

TRADESHOW + CONVENTION: Tradeshow workers assemble and build exhibits in shops, as well as install and dismantle them at show locations.

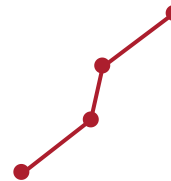


HIGH DEMAND
